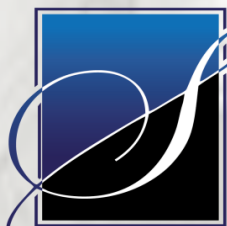
### NEW ENTRY FOYER 'THE CRYSTAL HALL'

#### The Story

The construction of a new transparent and unique entry foyer 'The Crystal Hall' and a 4.5m Bluestone ramp 'Museum Walk' inlaid with historic Indigenous Mungo Footprints, extends from College Street to the new entry. This project was undertaken in a very busy 'live' environment, sensitive to the needs of the Australian Museum's business continuity and daily visitors. The Crystal Hall boasts a pleated glass front facade housing coloured diamond louvres. The ceiling is comprised of a sophisticated design inclusive of services and acoustic attenuation, showcasing a steel tube finish - an innovative and the first all inclusive tubed ceiling system of its kind. The project includes the Sheltered Garden works built under the Crystal Hall and the 'Linkway' refurbishment works in the existing passageway that links the new entry into the Museum.
